Re: Response to DIPP for IPR Policy on SEP and FRAND

Govt. wants to make policy on SEP IPR licensing and FRAND. Last date for comments is 22.4.2016. This affects all of us and your comments must be filed please.

We appreciate your team in wonderful work done in this behalf. CMAI/TEMA has prepared a Paper, which is attached. It may look too big. However, we hope it will bring some good points to your team for response to Govt. as also for contest in legal matters. The note contain important support material for anticompetitive working of IPRs, royalty on components instead of entire product, global cases where royalties have been substantially reduced by Courts, global cases where patent claims have been found excessive and void, brief of various cases in Indian Courts, SSOs not informing the patents, Indian Govt. prescribing standards without knowing the patents/royalties, taxes on royalties not paid by patentees for other cases in India, justification and need of Compulsory licensing in India.

We are convening a meeting of IPR Expert Committee on 21.4.2016 at 2.30 PM at P 90 B South Extension Part II, New Delhi to discuss and consider response to Government.
