

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)**

Between

**Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation Ltd.,**

And

**CMAI Association of India,**

for

**Providing affordable purified drinking water and toilets  
at Railway Stations**

This Memorandum of Understanding i.e. MOU is made and entered into at New Delhi on this first day of October Two Thousand Fifteen.

**BETWEEN**

**Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation Ltd.**, a Public Sector Enterprise of the Ministry of Railways represented by **Shri Surendra Kumar, GGM/HRD** hereinafter referred to as "**IRCTC**" (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successor or successors, administrators and assigns) **of the First Part.**

**AND**

CMAI Association of India, an association registered under the laws of India having its Registered Office at C-73, Saket, New Delhi-110017, represented by Prof. NK Goyal the President of the Association (hereinafter referred to as "**CMAI**" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors, liquidators and assigns) party **of the Second Part.**

**WHEREAS** IRCTC, has been given the mandate to provide drinking water among other facilities at Stations in order to address the growing challenge of providing access to purified drinking water and toilets in certain Railway Stations.

**WHEREAS** CMAI has approached IRCTC to undertake the said challenge under various CSR scheme managed by the associations for various members of the association to reach the individuals.

**AND WHEREAS** IRCTC has accepted the proposal to assist the CMAI to achieve its obligation in the interest of general public.

**AND WHEREAS** CMAI has agreed to put a sum of Rs. 25,000/- per machine installed in a dedicated account to meet future funding of the operation of the project as imprest which will be subjected to joint review.

**NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND AMONG THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:**

**A. Period of MOU and its extension**

This MOU comes into effect from **1<sup>st</sup> October 2015** and will remain in force for a period of Two years. The validity of this MOU can be extended with mutual consent of the parties to this MOU. The extension will be done by adding an addendum to this MOU.
