Public Notice

This is to bring into the notice of all concerned that Department of Telecommunication, Government of India has decided to allow the Type Application Code (TAC) '01' and '35' to be utilized for R&D/ test/ prototype devices while registering on ICDR portal for issuance of IMEI certificates. This is in addition to TAC '00' to test prototype devices on network being utilized at present. Limit of 5000 lot size per model per year is to be observed for new series. In order to avail the facility, Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs)/ importers who are registrants on the portal <https://icdr.ceir.gov.in> need to upload the undertaking (proforma as enclosed)

Undertaking by OEM

The undertaking/declaration to be submitted by the OEM before registering R&D/test/prototype devices on ICDR portal with the TAC series '00', '01' or '35'

- (i) The samples are being imported for R&D/testing/Pre-launch purposes.
- (ii) The list of the IMEIs being imported for the purpose are uploaded on CDR portal.
- (iii) The IMEI of the device are in sync with the GSMA database.
- (iv) The prototype/test/R&D device will not be sold /distributed /used in the commercial network.
- (v) This device will either be exported back/ destroyed/ scrapped as the case may be, after its intended usage within 1 year from the date of certificate generation.
- (vi) The OEM takes full responsibility for any lapses in the usage beyond the purposes stated above. In case of violation, the facility of utilizing the TAC series beyond '00' for such devices shall be withdrawn.
