**CIRCULAR**

**Subject: Clarification on Testing Requirements under PPO and CRO**

MeitY has notified CCTV under the “Electronics & IT goods (Requirements for Compulsory Registration) Order 2021” and under the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) (PPP-MII) Order for compliance to safety standards (IS 13252) and Essential Requirements (ERs) for security on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2024 and 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024 respectively and the Orders have already come into effect from 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 and 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 respectively.

2. Based on the requests received from the industry and after due consideration by the competent authority, the sale of CCTV cameras notified under “Electronics & IT goods (Requirements for Compulsory Registration) Order”, which are manufactured or imported before 9<sup>th</sup> April 2025, is permitted in the domestic market, subject to compliance with IS 13252 until the expiry of registration number.
3. In this context, it is clarified that as per the provisions of the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, for supply of CCTVs to Government or Public Sector Enterprises, the registration with BIS based on compliance with the notified safety standards (IS 13252) and Essential Requirements both are mandatory.
4. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
