

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT: TSPs / OEMs

1. The Trusted Telecom Portal was launched on 15 June 2021 for use by TSPs and Equipment Suppliers.
2. TSP Registration on Trusted Telecom Portal. TSPs are advised to view the amendments in license conditions issued by DOT post the implementation of NSDTS (National Security Directive on Telecommunication Sector) along with the circulars posted on DOT website for necessary compliance and to take necessary actions.
3. OEM Registration on Trusted Telecom Portal.
 - a. Process of registration for OEM will only commence after a TSP has submitted inputs in the portal indicating the details of the OEM and the product of the OEM submitted by them for evaluation. In such case, OEM will receive a notification from TTC and the process of onboarding of OEM on the portal will be initiated.
 - b. OEMs then need to share the “Ink signed hard copy” of the Authority letter (see sample format below) along with the supporting board resolutions to the address given below:

 - c. Only once these documents are scrutinised and found correct, the OEM will be allowed to register in the portal. They will then get access to the Portal for filling details pertaining to their company and their products for evaluation.
4. Using the Portal. Once the TSP / OEM have registered successfully, they can view the detailed Help instructions for using the Trusted Telecom Portal. This is available under “Help Section” in the dashboard of TSP / OEM. Help section also has the list of equipment covered under the NSDTS.
