Dr Chaesub Lee is the Director of ITU's Telecommunication Standardization Bureau. Dr Lee has been involved in the telecommunication and ICT standardization field for 27 years, specializing in ISDN, GII, NGN, IPTV, Cloud computing.

Earlier he was with ETRI, Korea and worked at the Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST), and as a senior advisor to the Koreans Ministry, ICT and Future Planning (MSIP).

Within ITU Dr Lee served as Chairman of several Focus Groups such as NGN, IPTV, Study Group 13 Future Networks and Cloud, IOT etc.

## Mr. Shyamal Ghosh, IAS (Retd)



Mr. Ghosh IAS, a 1965-batch Gujarat cadre IAS officer has taken charge as Chairman of Telecom Equipment & Services Export Promotion Council (TEPC), a body promoted by Department of Telecom and Department of Commerce and promoted by TEMA.

He was also Chairman of Data Security Council of India and India Broadband Forum.

Mr Ghosh is known as an able administrator and responsible for implementation of the New Telecom Policy of 1999, taking initiative for drafting the Information Technology Act 2000 and initially proposing creation of Information Super Highway in India in 1997.
